NOTE:

- 1. The Sports Medicine resident must be primary board certified by one of the six entities listed above.**
- 2. The Sports Medicine fellow may take the exam prior to the completion of their training but must have completed 9 months of their fellowship program and must submit a letter of recommendation from their fellowship director stating that the fellow is qualified to take the exam. The fellow will be required to sign a waiver attesting to the fact that board scores will not be released to any fellow until the resident has submitted all required documentation, has successfully completed the fellowship program and has been approved by all involved agencies.**
