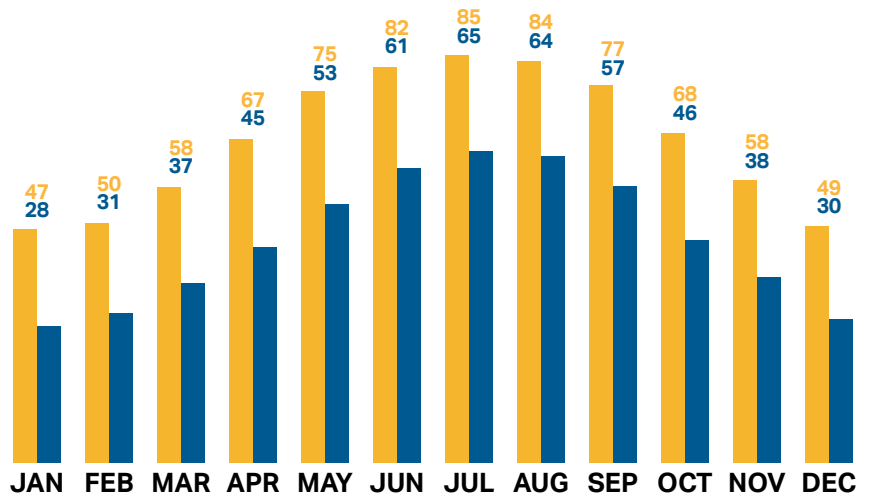


ASHEVILLE CLIMATE

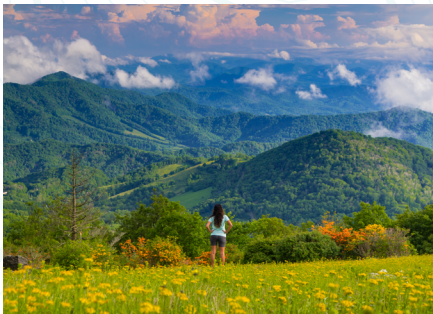

SPRING March-May

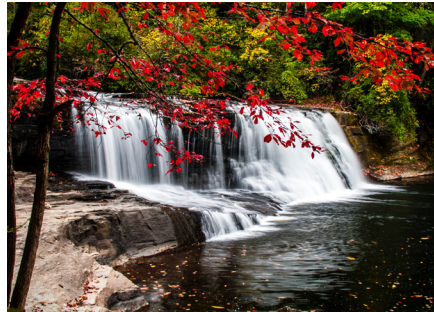
