One-On-One Customized MSK Ultrasound Learning Workshops

Course Content: The learner purchases 60-minute increments of one-on-one hands-on US scanning time with a MSK ultrasound expert to learn the sports ultrasound skills of their choice. This enables the learner to customize the contents of their learning session and to acquire a specific MSK ultrasound skill.

- These workshops will be available in the early mornings or compete against other AOASM course lecture times.
- 1-hour of CME will be awarded for each session.
- A volunteer sports medicine fellow will be the model. (If you are associated with a SM fellowship training program, you may bring your own fellow. Please notify AOASM or the course director ahead of time.)
